Beechcraft Flap Roller Lubrication Work Aid Instruction Card

- 1. Separate the two halves of the grease tool and Insert bearing.
- 2. Re-insert the threaded stud cap and lightly tighten by hand.
- 3. Connect a hand operated grease gun to the zerk and fill until grease is satisfactorily purged from the vent hole.
- 4. Unscrew and remove the threaded stud cap completely, then place a finger over the outside of the threaded hole and push the threaded stud cap back in. (This hydraulic action will pop up the bearing flange enough to grab and pull it out.)
- 5. Remove finger from the hole, then pull out threaded cap and bearing.
- 6. Presto. Bearing is now completely lubricated with minimal time and mess.
